

FUHSD Career Technical Education Advisory Committee
Meeting Minutes: 11/9/2020

- A. Meeting called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chair Walt Giacomini.** Members present were S. Dale, S. Poust, J. Plant, T. Miles, B. Roslosnik, H. Lovfald, L. Kleiner, S. Chatfield, A. Rocha, N. Sotomayer, S. McGrath, J. Sheppard.
- B. Minutes:** The minutes from 9/14/2020 were distributed via email for review. **It was moved, McGrath, and seconded, Miles, to approve the minutes.** Motion passed, unanimous voice vote.
- C. Review of Agenda:** Mr. Giacomini entertained any additions or changes to the agenda.
- D. Reports:** Reports were given by the following:
- Tony Miles / Stacy Chatfield:** reported on Husky Skills. All students who want to participate in competitions should be registered by Friday, November 13. There is a Skills USA meeting planned for this week where students will vote in officers. They are planning virtual meetings also.
- Hannah Lovfald:** reported on FFA activities. Fortuna had 36 students participate in the fair and sell animals. A total of \$118,000 was generated from the sales paid to Fortuna students alone. The members elected an officer team and they are meeting to plan additional activities. They had a Halloween drive thru meeting with 70 participants. The officer team held a virtual retreat also.
- Norm:** counselor activities include general support for CTE students. Norm has also been working on a presentation for CTE students on technical school and other options after graduation.
- Ann Marie:** Dual enrollment has been a focus with the Welding students completing their class and the ICT students just enrolling. She has also been working with the Middle School Ag project in ordering supplies. She is also developing a senior post graduate plans list to be able to better serve the graduating completers.
- E. Budget Updates:** Sarah Poust reported on the status of the remaining funds in the CTEIG 18-19 allocation and noted that they need to be spent by December. There is a balance of approximately 76,000 that will be spent by that date. There are additional funds in the 2019-20 allocation that will start in January. The CTE programs all received funds from the COVID-19 Learning Loss funding to aid with adjustments needed in the classrooms and shops for health and safety.
- F. Middle School Update:** Lindsey Kleiner reported that the middle school pilot project is moving along well. Jamie Lammori is teaching a section of Introduction to Agriculture at Rio Dell Middle School. Lindsey and Jamie have met to purchase lab supplies for the class. They have made

adaptations due to Covid-19 restrictions and the inability to conduct field trips this year. A SWP Application was submitted to secure funding for the next two years.

G. Senior Exit Survey Data: Sandy Dale shared the exit survey results with the committee.

H. Goals for 2020-21: The following goals were presented and discussed by the committee members.

1. To increase the number of program completers in all pathways by 5%.
2. To increase the number of students taking the next course in a pathway sequence by 5%.
3. To track and formalize the work based learning program at FUHSD.
4. To increase involvement in CTSO programs, Skills USA.
5. To investigate the development of an Arts, Media, and Entertainment Pathway.

Discussion items included the following concerns:

Will this be a competing pathway and take away from the success of the other pathways?

Any CTE course should be allowed to be a graduation requirement in place of art.

Programs lose students to the art graduation requirement. It should be reconsidered.

This inclusion of another pathway can put existing pathways in jeopardy and puts programs in a tough position.

There could be additional grant funding sought with the inclusion of this pathway.

The 11 Elements would need to be implemented.

The AME pathway could assist the ICT pathway and work together.

It was moved Sotomayer, and seconded Chatfield to approve the goals set for 2020-21. Motion passed.
